Getting a Position at NYSDEC

- Normally, must take the NYS Meteorology Civil Service Exam to be hired.
- If no exam is given, we can hire w/o exam
- The exam is usually given every few years.
- If you pass, you will be placed on a hiring list.

Current Hiring Conditions at DEC

Our section will likely be in need of a forecaster in the next couple of years.

We are usually given an intern position for the summer.
