- mainly pillow lava
- mafic volcanoclastics
- unspecified unit

- Slink Pond Pillow Lava Formation

- mafic lava, conglomerate
- quartz perthite porphyry eutaxitic ignimbrite
- sandstone
- porphyry, rhyolite, syenite - ring complex
