- S <u>Catfood gneiss</u> q-f. gneiss w/coarse flecks of biotite and garnet.
- Pinkeye gneiss blue to blue-gray q-f. gneiss w/ many pink augen. Dismembered fold hooks common (transposed).
- White gneiss dominantly pure to off-white q-f. gneiss w/ garnet. Some interlayers darker (biotite).
- b <u>Blue Ruin gneiss</u>- blue-grey q-f. gneiss w/few or no augen. Some interlayers of splen-dant biotite gneiss.
- Pinkstripe gneiss-q-f. gneiss w/biotite and prominent pink or yellow lineation.
- outcrop boundaries
- strike and dip of gneissic layering
