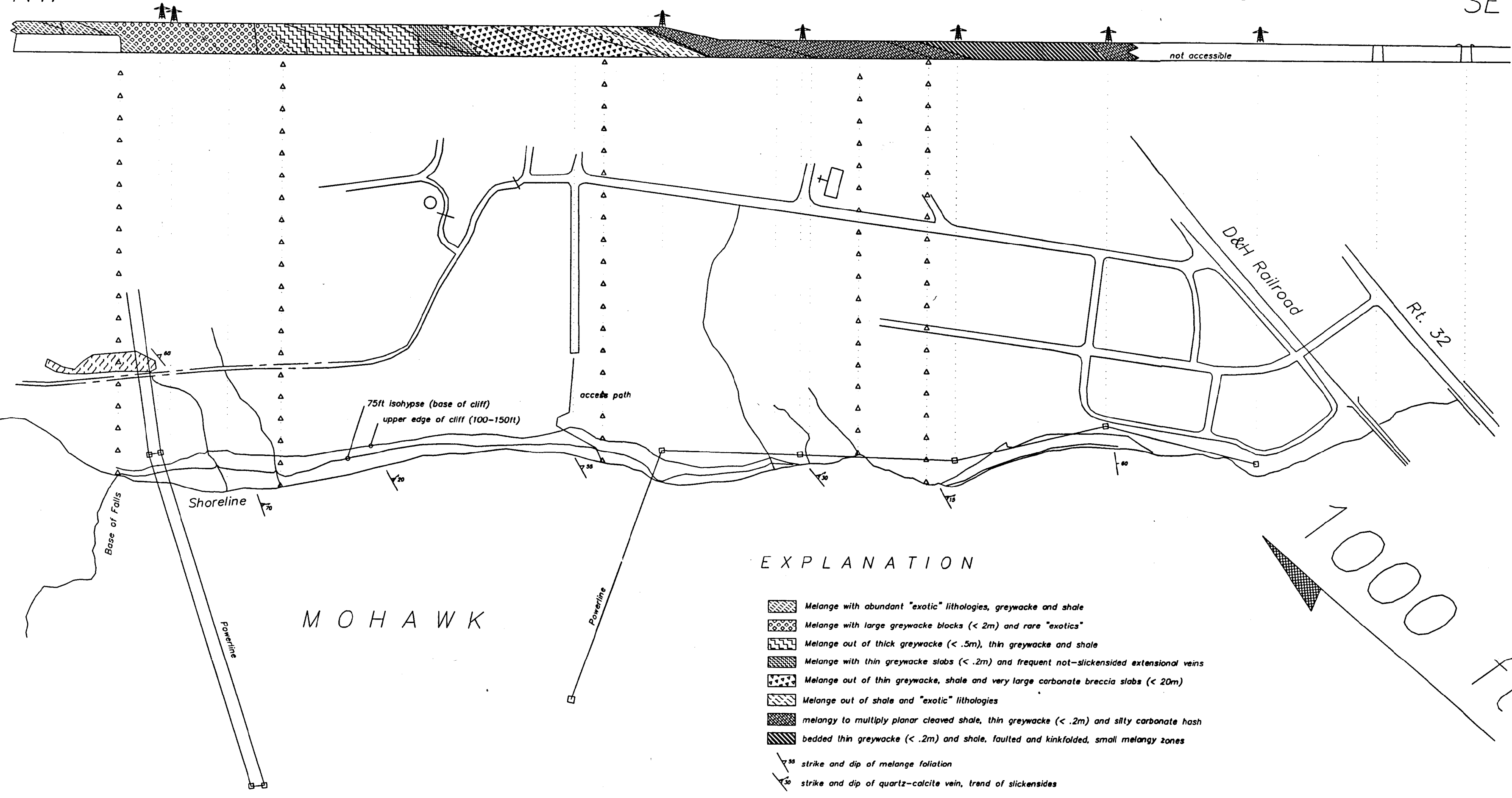

EXPLANATION

- Melange with abundant "exotic" lithologies, greywacke and shale
- Melange with large greywacke blocks (< 2m) and rare "exotics"
- Melange out of thick greywacke (< .5m), thin greywacke and shale
- Melange with thin greywacke slabs (< .2m) and frequent not-slickensided extensional veins
- Melange out of thin greywacke, shale and very large carbonate breccia slabs (< 20m)
- Melange out of shale and "exotic" lithologies
- melangy to multiply planar cleaved shale, thin greywacke (< .2m) and silty carbonate hash
- bedded thin greywacke (< .2m) and shale, faulted and kinkfolded, small melangy zones
- 35° strike and dip of melange foliation
- 30° strike and dip of quartz-calcite vein, trend of slickensides
