

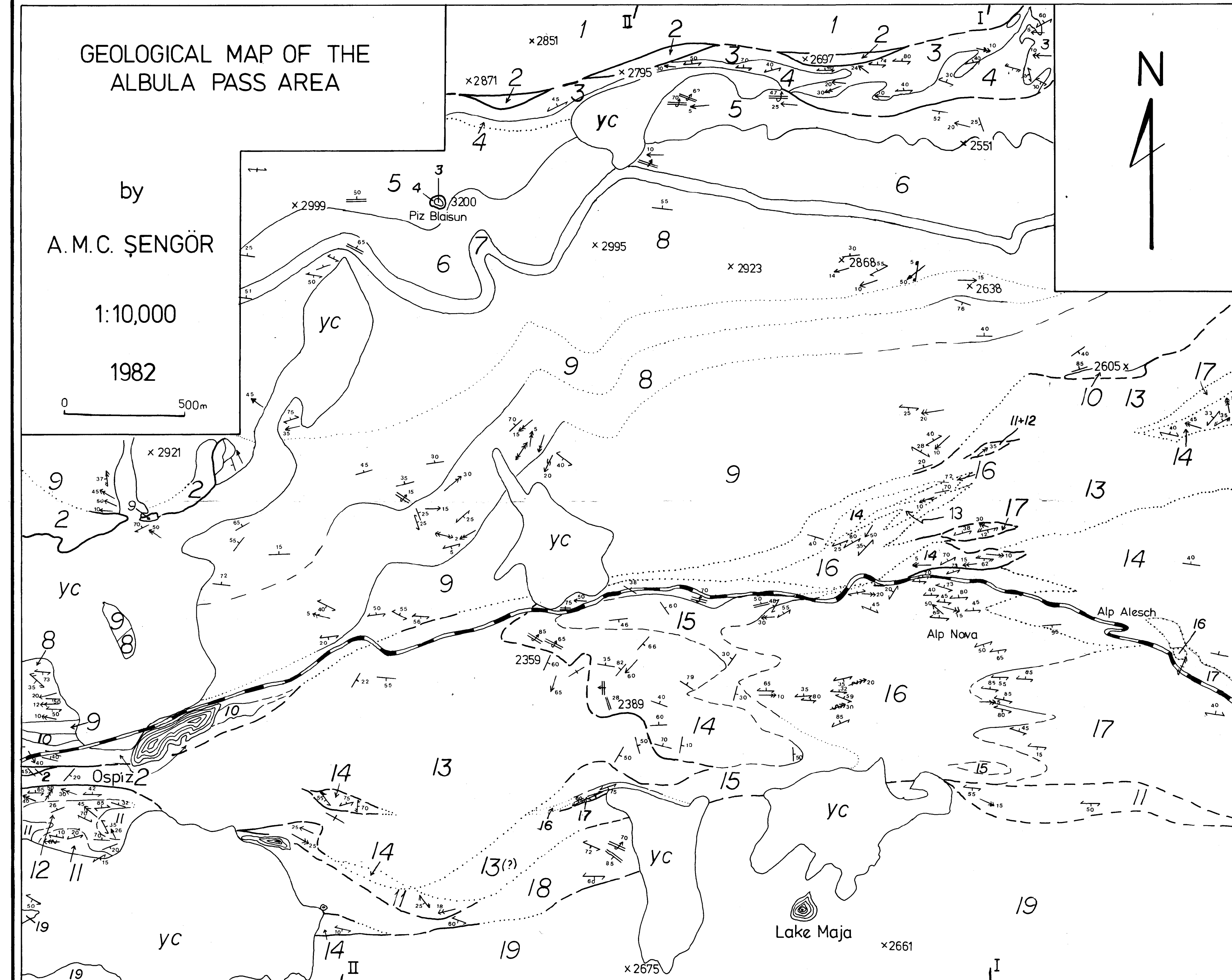
GEOLOGICAL MAP OF THE ALBULA PASS AREA
