THIRD CALL FOR PAPERS FOR THE 19th CYCLONE WORKSHOP

Dear colleagues:

We are pleased to announce the 19th Cyclone Workshop (CW) will be held beginning with dinner Sunday, 29 September, and ending after lunch on Friday, 4 October 2019, at Kloster Seeon near Munich in Germany. We would like to solicit contributions under the broad theme of ***“Meditating on the role of cyclones ...”***

- 1) ... in predictability.**
- 2) ... in high-impact weather.**
- 3) ... in large-scale circulation.**
- 4) ... from the tropics to the poles.**

In addition to these themes, the selection of workshop topics is open and will be determined by the interests of the participants. If it rotates, we want to hear about it! As with past CWs, we strongly encourage participation from the operational forecasting community.

The workshop will be held at Kloster Seeon (www.kloster-seeon.de/en) in Seeon, near Munich, Germany. In keeping with our strategy from past CWs, we will schedule afternoon recreation breaks, at least one poster session, and special evening sessions. Proposed topics include “The 101st anniversary of the Bergen School” and “Ensemble visualization of cyclones”. Any suggestions regarding either the topics or the format of the evening sessions are welcome and should be sent to the Organization or Science Committee members. Given the success of past CWs and our desire to maximize discussion time, expected participants should be aware that there will likely be limitations on the overall number of presentations and participants.

The rooms at Kloster Seeon will include all meals. Single rooms will be 133€ per night. Double rooms will be 153€ and 197€ per night for single and double occupancy, respectively. To make a reservation, participants will contact the venue by email (info@kloster-seeon.de) and mention the “Cyclone Workshop”. Please provide the contact information of both persons if you want to share a double room and the bill will be split. If you are willing to share a room and are looking for a colleague with whom to do so, please contact the Organization Committee. The reservation deadline is **15 June 2019**.

The amount of travel support will be 700€. Criteria for selection will be scientific quality and the letter of interest. The

committee will strive to balance travel awards between working groups and institutions. A decision on travel support will be made by **15 May 2019**.
